

1st Six Weeks Project: Bio Poem

You will create a poem that contains certain elements that review material from Spanish 1. You must follow the structure of the example provided on the handouts, write it entirely in Spanish, and decorate the final product. Do not do this on anything larger than a ½ size poster board. You may NOT use a translator or get help from a native speaker, but you may use a dictionary or your book. However, try to stick to what you know and can remember. No two autobiographic poems should be similar in content! Except for the poem structure, you **may not repeat** entire lines provided in the Sample poem attached!!

First Name

- Line 1: (4) different adjectives. (Reviews: adjectives and agreement of adjectives).
- Line 2: (1) Relationship to others (Reviews: family vocabulary and customs)
- Line 3: (3) Who loves...weather expression/ animal/ sport.
- Line 4: (2) Who feels...one positive and one negative emotion.
- Line 5: (3) Who needs...one leisure activity, one sport, AND anything else.
- Line 6: (2) Who prefers...one food AND anything else.
- Line 7: (3) Who fears...one world problem OR one personal problem.
- Line 8: (3) Who has to... one household chore- including house vocab (Voc. 1.2)
- Line 9: (3) Who does not like...anything here is OK- food, chores, etc.
- Line 10: Who lives in... Street name OR City, STATE, COUNTRY
